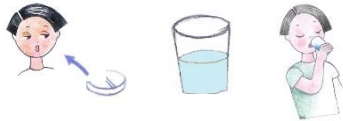


## 1 What is terbinafine for?

This medicine eliminates the fungi that have infected your skin and hair.

## 2 How and when to take this medicine



Swallow the tablet with a glass of water ...

**OR** grind up the tablet. If you decide to grind it up, you **must take the medicine straight away**.

You can mix it with a spoonful of fruit compote or yoghurt, **but do not mix it with water!**



Weight: ..... kg                      Prescribed dose: ..... mg



Take the whole tablet  
(250 mg)



Cut the tablet in two and take half  
(125 mg)



Cut the tablet in 4 and take  $\frac{1}{4}$   
(62.5 mg)



**Once a day,  
at the same time,  
with meals.**



## 3 How to store terbinafine



This medicine should be stored at room temperature, in its packaging, until its expiry date.



## 4 What to do if you miss a dose

**Do not double the next dose!**

If you miss a dose, do not double the next dose, just continue your treatment normally.

## 5 Other precautions to take during your treatment

- Be sure to apply the cream locally
- Cut hair short
- Wash sheets, towels, etc. at 60 °C
- **A liver function test may be required before and possibly during treatment (not systematic)**
- To avoid any interaction with other treatments, tell your doctor or pharmacist that you are taking this medicine!



## 6 What should you monitor during your treatment with TERBINAFINE?

### In the event of:

- loss of appetite, persistent abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, abnormal crying, unusual fatigue
- dark urine, discoloured stools, yellow skin
- fever, sore throat, bleeding, particularly from the gums
- skin rash or redness

## 1 What is itraconazole for?

This medicine eliminates the fungi that have infected your skin and hair.

## 2 How to take this medicine



Swallow the capsule with a glass of water.  
Do not open the capsule.

## 3 When to take this medicine

**Once a day**, at the same time,  
**outside meals.**

**Do not eat for at least one hour** after taking  
this medicine.

## 4 How to store itraconazole



This medicine should be stored at  
room temperature, in its  
packaging, until its expiry date.



## 5 What to do if you miss a dose

**Do not double the next dose!**

If you miss a dose, do not double the next dose,  
just continue your treatment normally  
the next day.



## 6 Other precautions to take during your treatment

- Be sure to apply the cream locally
- Cut hair short
- Wash sheets, towels, etc. at 60 °C
- **A liver function test may be required before and possibly during treatment (not systematic)**

- **To avoid any interaction with other treatments, tell your doctor or pharmacist that you are taking this medicine!**



## 6 What should you monitor during your treatment with ITRACONAZOLE?

### In the event of:
